# SECONDARY CHAMPION SCHOOL BASKETBALL OVERVIEW - 2025

In 2025, most Leagues will be run as day-carnivals, however, there will be North of the River and a South of the River Specialist Schools Leagues run as an after-school home and away competition throughout Terms 1 and 2. These Leagues are only open to schools offering a Specialist Basketball Program.

### **Senior Competition**

- North of the River and South of the River Specialist Programs Leagues (Champion Schools) played on a home and away basis after school throughout Terms 1 and 2
- Regional Leagues (All-Schools) played as day-carnivals during Term 2

The **Champion Schools** Grand Final will be contested by the **two top teams** determined after the NOR and SOR home and away competition, followed by cross-over semi finals.

The <u>top team</u> from each of the **Regional League day-carnivals** will be invited to attend the All-Schools Day Carnival. The **two top teams** at the completion of the All Schools Day Carnival will progress to the **Senior All-Schools** Grand Final.

All Grand Finals will be held at Bendat Stadium on a date to be advised during Term 2 in 2025.

There is a possibility that Specialist Schools may enter their second or third teams as development teams in the Reginal All-Schools day carnivals, however, these teams will be ineligible to progress to the All Schools finals.

### **Junior Competition**

Junior Leagues will conduct their competitions as one-day carnivals. All **Specialist Schools** will compete in their own day carnivals separate to the **All-Schools** day carnivals. The **two top teams** from each of the Specialist Day Carnivals will contest the **Junior Champion Schools** Grand Final.

Following the completion of the **Regional Junior Leagues day-carnivals**, the **top team** from each League will be invited to attend the All-Schools Day Carnival. The **two top teams** at the completion of the All Schools Day Carnival will progress to the **All-Schools** Grand Final.

There is a possibility that Specialist Schools may enter their second or third teams as development teams in the Reginal All-Schools day carnivals, however, these teams will be ineligible to progress to the All Schools finals.

# **CHAMPION SCHOOLS BASKETBALL 2025**

### AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. To improve the standard of basketball in schools.
- 2. To improve the image of schools as a focal point of a student's sporting life.
- 3. To encourage sports persons to continue their education.
- 4. To identify and strengthen a strong sense of loyalty to the school and a strong school spirit for the competitors, students, staff, parents and the Community.
- 5. To make High Schools self-sufficient in the techniques and skills of administering a high standard basketball competition.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. All High Schools in the State of Western Australia, including Government and Non-Government High Schools in both the metropolitan and country areas.
- 2. Each school may nominate one boys and one girls team in each division. If places in the League allow, schools may nominate a second team with the approval of the Organising Committee and League Coordinator.
- 3. The divisions are:
  - Senior Champion School (years 7 -12, 18 years or under in the year of competition).
  - Junior Champions Schools (years 7- 9, and 15 years or under in the year of competition)
  - Year 7 3X3
  - Year 10 3X3
- 4. Players must be enrolled full-time at the school.
- 5. Players come from any year group for the Senior Competitions, and must be years 7 9 for the Junior Competition

### **COMPETITION STRUCTURE**

### 1. Leagues

All schools wishing to compete will be placed in a "League" which will be arranged by geographic areas.

### 2. League Co-ordinators

Each League will have a "League Co-ordinator" who will be responsible for setting up a round-robin or all-day competition. The purpose of the round robin or day-carnival is to select the best teams in each league to progress to the finals series.

#### 3. Dates

The Senior Champion Schools competitions will be conducted in Terms 1 and 2, and the Junior Champion Schools will be conducted in Term 3 of the school year.

### **Senior Competitions**

Nominations completed online with School Sport WA

Fixtures e-mailed to schools by League Co-ordinators following close of nominations.

Each League will start at the decision of the Coordinator depending on number of teams, as long as games are completed by Friday 16 May 2025.

Friday 16 May 2025 – Last day for Regional games. Tuesday 10 June 2025 – All Schools League Winners' day carnival Tuesday 1 July 2025 - Boys / Girls Grand Finals – (Girls 3.00pm Tip off; Boys 4.30pm Tip off).

### **Junior Competitions**

Dates for all Junior Carnivals will be set in Term 2 to allow schools time to organise. These will be published on <a href="https://www.schoolsportwa.com.au/interschool/secondary/basketball/">https://www.schoolsportwa.com.au/interschool/secondary/basketball/</a>

All Junior carnivals will take place during week 3 to 5 of term 3 (4 August – 24 August 2025)
Tuesday 26 August 2025 – All Schools League Winners Day Carnival
Tuesday 23 September 2025 – Boys / Girls Grand Final (Girls 3.00pm Tip off; Boys 4.30pm Tip off).

# 4. Finals

Finals fixtures will be arranged by the School Sport WA Basketball Coordinator. Senior finals will be held out of school hours.

Senior Finals will be in two divisions:

<u>Senior Champion Schools Basketball</u> – Winners from the cross-over finals between the NOR and SOR Specialist Leagues, with the winning school in both boys and girls being invited to attend the National Schools Championships Division conducted by Basketball Australia.

<u>Senior All Schools Basketball</u> – Teams will play in their own Leagues, followed by a day carnival for the winners of each League. The top two teams from this day carnival will contest the All-Schools Grand Final.

Schools are only permitted to play in **ONE** division in the Senior Finals.

<u>Junior League</u> – Grand finals will be held at the Bendat Basketball Centre, after the completion of North and South of the River Specialist Schools finals and the All-Schools Leagues. The winning teams from each League carnival will play off in the All Schools League Winners' day carnival, with the top two teams contesting the Grand Final.

### 5. Venues

The venues for the All Schools and Reginal Leagues day carnivals and all Grand Finals will be booked by the relevant League Coordinator or SSWA. Venues for the Specialist League competitions will be determined by the relevant fixtures, with the HOME team responsible for arranging the venue.

#### 6. Fixtures

The fixtures (days and times of competition) for the leagues will be set up by the League Coordinators in co-operation with all school representatives of their League.

# 7. Game Timing

The timing of all finals games will be 4 x 10 minute quarters; fully timed (the clock will stop on all whistles).

The timing of all Specialist League games will be  $4 \times 10$  minute quarters; fully timed (the clock will stop on all whistles). In addition, a 24-second Shot Clock is to be used for all games as much as is practicable.

# 8. Referees

The grand finals will be refereed by qualified Basketball WA referees. Sport Staff One (<a href="https://ssoaustralia.com/">https://ssoaustralia.com/</a>) and Reffing Hoops (<a href="mailto:enquiries@reffinghoops.com.au">enquiries@reffinghoops.com.au</a>) have indicated they may be able to assist schools with the provision of referees throughout the year.

For ALL qualifying games, schools in each League must supply ONE competent referee. Referees used by schools must have refereed previously (Students or external referees) or have significant knowledge of the rules of basketball (teachers).

### 9. Team Make-up

The teams in this competition may consist of between five and twelve players.

### 10. Numbers

The following numbers may be worn on player uniforms: 00 - 99.

# **ACC vs SSWA ALL-STARS GAME**
