REGULATIONS

Events and Year Groups / Ages

Events will be conducted in year groups. There will be an age cutoff for the year group. The age cutoff for the year group is 30th June. The following cutoffs will apply:

Year Group	Age cutoffs
Year 7	1 July 2012 – younger
Year 8	1 July 2011 – 30 June 2012
Year 9	1 July 2010 – 30 June 2011
Year 10	1 July 2009 – 30 June 2010
Open	Before 30 June 2009

Schools will compete for the following shields for A and B Grade:

Lower School Shield Upper School Shield Champion School Meritorious Shield

Student Entry

Schools will receive information on how to nominate their students and place them in their events before the end of Term 1.

CARNIVAL SET UP

This year, we have changed the terminology to assist school as per the recommendation at the HOLAs meeting in March.

The Carnival will be split to an Division 1 and Division 2 with schools allocated to one of these divisions.

Division 1 schools

Will be allocated to Heats A – E Heat A will be for all individual events – the highest division. Heats B to D will be the second, third and fourth division of the 100m only Heat E will be for the Relay.

Division 2 schools

Will be allocated to Heats F – J Heat F will be for all individual events – the highest division Heats G to I will be the second, third and fourth division of the 100m only. Heat J will be for the Relay.

Hopefully this will ensure this is easier for you to allocate.

Year Group Champions:

All events will count towards individual champion points.

Equipment:

Each school is responsible for bringing its own requirements, eg starting blocks, relay batons, etc. Relay batons to be a standard 30 cm in length. Equipment should show the school's name on it.

Equipment for Throws will be provided by the Bunbury Little Athletics Club.

Throwing events

In order to match up with Athletics West we have implemented the following weights for throwing events. The only difference to Athletics West recommendations is the Year Boys discus which will remain at 1kg.

Relays:

No Competitor is permitted to enter in more than one relay event.

Members of a team other than the first runner may commence not more than 10 metres outside the changeover zone (10m). A distinctive mark will be made in each line to denote the runners' extended limit.

Events for Boys and Girls – Year 7,8,9,10 and Open:

100m (4 heats), 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Javelin, Shot Put, Discus, 4 x 100m Relay.

There is no restriction on the number of events for which an individual may enter, providing the events are in accord with the particular age group.

A student cannot participate in two age groups on the day, excepting if they go into a higher relay team if they aren't in the relay team in their age group.

Number of Competitors:

Individual - For both divisions one (1) competitor per school in all events except for the 100m where 4 competitors are allowed.

Relays - one (1) team per age group.

Meritorious Shield

The Meritorious Shield is calculated by:

School's overall points / the TOTAL (years 7-12) school population.
